Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25pence for every £1 donated.

Under existing tax law, higher rate taxpayers can claim relief on the difference between basic rate and higher rate or additional rate tax. If you pay Income Tax at the higher rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, we suggest you speak to your tax adviser who will be able to advise you.
